

CHAMPAGNE MAILLY GRAND CRU

*Blessed with a unique terroir in the legendary area of “Montagne de Reims”,
Mailly Grand Cru makes every single one
of its Champagnes from Grand Cru grapes, a truly exceptional case.*



Champagne Maily Grand Cru is located in the village of Maily-Champagne on the Northern slope of the “Grande Montagne de Reims” and is independently owned by 77 vine-growers of the village. Blessed with a unique terroir, the vineyard is distinguished by a location that faces all four points of the compass. Most of the plots are north-facing, favouring subtle, well-balanced wines.

Nestling in the centre of these vine-covered slopes is the winery: a glass building built above seven different levels of cellars and a kilometre-long stretch of ‘crayères’ (chalk caves). This is where Maily Grand Cru Champagne is made, exclusively from Maily Champagne grapes. Their 70ha vineyard, exclusively planted of Pinot Noir (75%) and Chardonnay (25%), is classified 100% Grand Cru, the top of the range.

In the 324 “crus” (or vine-villages) representing the whole Champagne area, only the grapes grown in 17 of them are judged worthy to wear the Grand Cru appellation. Rare and highly valuable, those very special grapes are usually used as part of the blend of the Prestige Cuvées of the Grandes Marques. As an exceptional and almost unique case in the whole of Champagne, Maily Grand Cru makes every single of its 500.000 yearly bottles exclusively out of Grand Cru grapes coming from its own vineyards.
